

پارسی / فارسی I Intermediate Persian I 01-013-276:01

Course description:

The Intermediate Persian I (01-013-276:01) is a continuation of Elementary Persian II (01:013:177). This course introduces students to a series of themes in Persian alongside Persian grammar, vocabulary and the four language skills at the intermediate low level. Emphasis is placed on actively using the language for interpersonal, interpretive, and presentational modes of communication. The four language skills (i.e., listening, speaking, reading, and writing) as well as pronunciation and culture are integrated into the curriculum. In this course, we will also draw on Persian stories, mythologies or literature to also learn about the cultural dimension of the Persian language.

Course Delivery

This course is synchronous online course, with the students and instructor meeting online twice a week through "Meetings" conferencing tool on Sakai. There will also be assignments and activates that will have to be completed by the students on the Sakai website within a specified time frame.
